



Step 1. Install Steam....

If you don't already have Steam installed on your PC, you will need it to download and play rFactor. Steam is a library of games, an online game store as such.


Got to <https://store.steampowered.com/> and click on the Install Steam button and follow the prompts.

You will be required to create an account using an email, user name and password. Steam will send you an email to confirm your account. Once you click the link to confirm you will be prompted to enter a user name and password. You will need to remember this each time you log into the game.




Once you have setup your steam account, you can got to Store, and search for and purchase Rfactor.

***Make sure you get rFactor, not rFactor2!**



Step 2. Install rFactor.....


Once you have purchased rFactor you will be prompted to install the game. If you miss the prompt, you can go to Library to see your list of games, and from perform the installation.



Once in rFactor, you will now need to enter a profile.
To make it easier for HQ ESeries Admins to identify drivers, it is asked that all drivers enter their real names.
This will also help with the point score.

Helmet, nationality Team name etc. can all be set here too

Once you have finished entering your profile and can see a car on the spinner, you are ready to get the mighty HQ's into the game!



Step 3.


Download & Install HQ Cars and Tracks.....

HQ Xtra have created a link for all the files you need to go HQ racing online. Including all the Aussie tracks from today, and even some that have unfortunately disappeared.

Select this link:



and download the rFactor.zip folder.



Once your files have downloaded, unzip them (right click, extract all) and copy the rFactor folder.

You need to paste the rFactor folder into:
Program Files/Steam/ steamapps/ common.
Overwrite your current rFactor folder and say yes to overwrite all.

Step 4. Wheel Setup.....

Wheel settings are something you can play with to find the best “feel” for you. It also differs between brands and models of wheels. Here are some recommendations to get started.

Search on your PC for Game Controllers and select the properties for your controller.

For HQ's on rFactor I use 600 degrees of rotation. This means to not have to turn the wheel so far to get input.

Enable Force Feedback


Set Effects strength to 100%

Spring Effect is 0%

Damper Effect 100%



Enable Centering spring, but reduce to 0%. (This seems odd but it is important for this game.

Allow Game to adjust settings.




Step 4. Wheel Setup.....

In game control settings are also up to personal preference.
Play around with it to get the best feel for you.




All the above preferences have been included in the rFactor folder you installed. Look for HQ Racing in the wheel presets. You will need to reassign your controls and buttons under mapping to suit your controller.

Step 4. In Game Settings.....




*If your game is jittery or not running smoothly, try lowering some of the display settings. Start by lowering the amount of visible cars.

QUICK REFERENCE KEYBOARD CONTROLS

CAMERA VIEWS

Insert - Switches between cockpit, roof, and nose cameras on the vehicle

Home - Switches between other onboard cameras

Page Up - Switches to swingman camera/ Then use number pad # to swing

Page Down - Switches to trackside cameras so you can view the race from a spectator's point of view

1 - Vote Yes in multiplayer

2 - Get ping value to server

3 - Toggle your mirrors on and off

4 - Toggle the HUD (Heads Up Display) statistics display

5 - Toggle the HUD tachometer display

6 - Toggle the HUD multi-purpose display

7 - Toggle TV overlays

0 - Vote No in multiplayer

Enter - Cycles Information displayed on your dash or HUD

Framerates - Shift+f

Tab - Toggles the driver names above the cars
